The Do of Tosei Gusoku style armour

During the Sengoku Period (period of warring states), new weapons like guns including spears and bows came to utilized in battlefields. The 'firearms unit' reportedly introduced by 'Oda Nobunaga' beat the cavalry which was led by 'Takeda Katsuyori' and said the strongest at that time. Because of that, the awareness that the gun was superior to all weapons was common. 'Tosei' means a current style and 'Gusoku' says all parts of arms (helmets, masks, shoulder protectors, gloves for sword, shin protectorsand so on) are provided. Tosei Gusoku was also named as modern armour which had perfect capabilities of being defended. Tosei Gusoku was suitable for both cavalry and infantry battles. As for Tosei Gusoku, there was no discrimination of armour style depending on

warriors' ranks like Oyoroi for high-class commanders and like Keiko for lower-class solders. And it functioned as uniforms of one team and as well as identification friend or foe. It also had an effect to unite as one group.



The number of battles all over Japan were increasing explosively in Sengoku Period. So. there was no time to make a lot of armour with spending time. When armourers created Domaru armour, Haramaki and Haraate they

boards made of iron and leather which were called 'Kozane' with silk thread and leather straps and completed them. But that needed long time to bind each Kozane one by one. Due to the trend of such times, the armourers tied firm iron plates and similar materials and were going to produce strong Do for protecting the body of warriors simply. That is 'Itamono Do'.

This was DO which was interlaced and produced by 'Sugake Odoshi', the Mogami Do technique to tie rectangle boards together one by one in piles with thread.

Another method to link plates with four hinges was also introduced. That contributed the progress of Tose Gusoku armour style which had various kinds. And this style made it possible to create Do with only rectangle boards. By these manufacturing methods, the process of making armour was shortened dramatically and they enabled to produce simple and tough DO which was demanded for Tosei Gusoku armour style. Mogami Do can be said a pioneer of Tosei Gusoku style armour as | Sugake well. (It is said to be made in Mogami Region-currently in Yamagata Prefecture).







This is Do to link each one plate with hinges, not threads, and fix it. Yoko-Okegawa Do hagi Do nailing horizontally long iron plates together and Tatehagi Do connecting vertically them in conjunction are collectively called Okegawa Do. OkeGawa Do looks like the side (Gawa) of Japanese tub (Oke). You can most often find this style of Tosei Gusoku armour. By the way,



in order to put on and taken off the armour easily, the stuff to split Do into two (front and rear) parts and connect them with a hinge on the left side is 'Nimai Do' (Nimai means 'two') and the other stuff to split Do into five pieces is called 'Gomai Do' (Gomai means 'five').

What was required for Tosei Gusoku style armour was toughness and easiness. But I feel that it never means being made poorly. It shows that armourers created Do to save the lives of solders by theirfine skills and ideas. I am going to tell you another DO to improve Mogami Do and Okegawa Do more in the next column.

There are various views about when the temple was originated. But it is said to be in 1468. Amago Kiyosada, the father of Amago Tsunehisa, founded the temple

at Kanao, Takanoyama, in Bingo Province. You can find the Yakushi-do hall in the precinct. In it, Yakushi Nyorai (Healing Buddha) is placed, which is said the actual origin of Dokoji Temple. When Hisatsune entered Gassantoda Castle and was annoyed with his sickness, he made his earnest supplications to the Yakushi Nyorai. After that, Hisatsune had allegedly recovered completely by dreaming of YakushiNyorai's spirit strangely.

This place was planned and created by Hirose Mikaduki Boy Scouts in order to commemorate the 2.600 years of the Imperial Era, In 1565, Mori Force attacked Gassantoda Castle where Amago Clan lived for destroying Amago Clan. The well-guarded castle and resistance by Amago Force made the battle never-ending. Shinagawa Masakazu, a solder of Mori Force who wanted to raise his status as a warrior, decided to win Yamanaka Yukimori, a commander of Amago Force who was known for his military prowess, with a single combat. Masakazu applied this fight to Yukimori. Shinagawa Masakazu changed his name to 'Taragi Ookaminosuke Kastsumori' in order to defeat Yamanaka Shikanosuke(Yukimori). This name was said to have two meanings. The first meaning was that horns of deer (Shika)

olt when new Aralia Sprouts (Tara) appear. The second meaning was that I was a wolf (Ookami) to eat a deer (Shika).

Masakazu applied one-on-one struggle.

Yukimori agreed with it and jumped in Toda River. But....

Masakazu had some arrows and aimed at Yukimori.

Another commander of Amago Force: 'you are so unfair! Battle on the ground with your sword!' . This commander cut the string of bow Masakazu had with his Karimata arrowhead.

Masakazu drew his sword and slashed at Yukimori

The battle with swords by Yukimori and Masakazu. They kept on having a fierce battle for about two hours. But the battle did not end.

Masakazu: 'ok, next, let' s make a scuffle and finish this battle'

Yukimori and Masakazu started a dogfight. Masakazu overwhelmed and suppressed Yukimori with his power.

Yukimori scooped out Masakazu's thigh with his short sword twice from the bottom, drove weakened Masakazu back and reversed the situation. Finally, Yukimori succeeded in cutting off Masakazu's head and killing him.

This single combat made the military name of Yukimori well-known and enabled Amago Force to boost its power. However, it allegedly had little effect to whole progress of battle.

The history of ruined Gassantoda Castle

It is said that Taira No Kagekiyo transferred Hachiman-sha Shrine and built the Castle.

1392 Kyogoku Takanori appointed Amago Mochihisa, his nephew, as Shugodai (the acting Military Governor). After him, Amago Clan had built up the military force with this castle for generations.

1484 Amago Hisatsune was expelled because of his misconducts.

1486 Amago Hisatsune made a blindside attack and got back the castle. Hisatune made some improvements of the castle.

1541 Amago Hisatune had passed away

1565 The Castle was surrounded by Mori Forces. Amago Clan barricaded themselves in the castle.


It was a place where the drums to announce the time were beaten. Now, the statue of Yukimori stands.
